OPTIONAL PROCEDURES	 Must first be credentialed in the core procedures Must have worked continuously in the specialized area over a period of three (3) or more months Attachment for very specialized procedures, time frame will be decided by the specialized area concerned The procedures must be certified by specialist relevant to the procedure
