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GENERAL INFORMATION

1. INTRODUCTION

Pre Hospital Care Services (PHCS) in general terms means the caring of patients outside of hospital. It covers a wide range of medical conditions, medical interventions and physical locations. The medical conditions can range from minor illness and injury to life threatening emergencies. The intervention also ranges from first aid to advanced emergency care.

In Ministry of Health Malaysia, the caring of patients outside of hospitals are provided by Allied Health professionals (AHP) mainly from Emergency and Trauma Services (EMTS) and also supported by the those from Primary Healthcare Services.

EMTS has its own credentialing process and criteria in the National Credentialing Committee (NCC). Many of the criteria include the intervention that are carried into the pre hospital arena. However, performance of a particular medical intervention in the hospital is not similar to performing it in out of hospital setting. The out of hospital setting has a wide range of physical locations where an intervention must be carried out and performed effectively.

The role of AHP in hospital environment are mainly to assist physicians in caring of the patients whilst in the PHCS they are the team leader that prescribes and provide the necessary intervention for patients with the aid of protocols. Thus, the credentialing assessment for AHP in PHCS focuses on competency of an AHP to assess, correctly prescribe and successfully provide the intervention required for a patient independent of a direct supervision of physician.

Since AHP in MOH are the only providers of Advanced Life Support intervention in PHCS; thus it is only fitting that the EMTS credentials the AHP whom are able to perform ALS interventions in PHCS. The terms ALS intervention in PHCS describes a responder whom is able to provide advanced airway intervention and provide pharmacological intervention in the field.

2. OBJECTIVES

- 2.1. Provide a process of training, evaluation and assessment of competency of AHP in performing specifics tasks safely in the PHCS environment.
- 2.2. Identification of AHP whom have achieved the necessary competency to perform specifics tasks safely in the PHCS environment.
- 2.3. Creation of AHP whom can role models and subject matter experts to other staff in the service.

3. SPECIALTY SUB-COMMITTEE IN CREDENTIALING FOR PRE HOSPITAL CARE

In the initial phase of carrying out this credentialing programme, the Specialty Sub-Committee in Credentialing for EMTS (SCC in EMTS) will increase its members to include Emergency Physician (EP) and AHP whom have special interest in the field of PHCS. However, in the long term, there is a need to have a separate SCC in PHCS. This separation would be in line with the Minister of Health vision of PHCS as a separate service on its own.

4. CREDENTIALING CRITERIA FOR PHCS

- 4.1. In the initial phase of the credentialing process within the first 6 months, a special clause would be applied to selected AHP working in the EMTS whom has the following credentials
 - 4.1.1. Has more than 5 years of experience working in EMTS especially in the field of PHCS.
 - 4.1.2. Have successfully passed the National PHCS ALS Competency Examination which is jointly organized by the College of Emergency Physician (CEP) with EMTS of Ministry of Health and also Medical Assistant Board (MAB).
- 4.2. There after the AHP is divided into two broad categories
 - 4.2.1. AHP with more than 2 years of experience working in EMTS
 - **4.2.2.** AHP with post basic qualifications of either Advanced Emergency Medicine and Trauma Course (AEMTC) or Advanced Diploma in Emergency Care (ADEC).
- 4.3. Based on the categories, the AHP must fulfil specific criteria as outlined in Appendix 1.

5. APPLICATION PROCESS

- **5.1.** Applicants must complete the following items (refer to *Appedix 2*):
 - 5.1.1. Completed AHP 1 and AHP 1(a) Application for Credentialing form
 - 5.1.2. Completed AHP 2 Applicant Appraisal form

- 5.1.3. Copy of Basic Diploma or Degree qualification that has been certified as true.
- 5.1.4. Copy of Registration to Medical Assistant Board or Nursing Board that has been certified as true.
- 5.1.5. Copy of Annual Practicing Certificate that has been certified as true.
- 5.1.6. Copy of Post Basic Qualification or Certification that has been certified as true.
- 5.1.7. Copy of National PHCS ALS Competency Examination Certification that has been certified as true.
- 5.1.8. Summary of logbook (if required) that has been certified as true (refer to Appendix 3).
- 5.2. All completed forms must be sent to respective profession body of the applicant.

6. ROLE OF CREDENTIALING IN PHC AT NATIONAL PERSPECTIVE

The SCC EMTS considered the need for a national credentialing programme for PHC responders from sectors outside of Ministry of Health. Implementation of National PHCS ALS Competency Examination as a pre-requisite of credentialing allows objective assessment of responder competency from all sectors within and outside of MOH. However for now it is only at ALS Competency Level.

7. CONCLUSION

The EMTS envisions that with the establishment of discipline specific criteria for credentialing of responder in PHCS, we would be moving in positive direction in creating a new Allied Health Professional field in the medical services of the country.
